

Local Authority reviews

We have had 3 reviews already this year from the Local Authority that were requested in September, before we had our visit from Ofsted. The numeracy review took time to look at how students transfer skills across different subjects e.g. graph drawing in Maths, Geography and Science. We will be writing a school numeracy policy to action the small improvements suggested.

Our SEND Review was comprehensive looking at SEND interventions, strategic planning, and adaptive teaching across the curriculum. Mr Winward joined the Local Authority team prior to joining us this term and will be working with our SEND team, professional development lead, curriculum leaders and pastoral colleagues as we start to plan 2024/25 improvements to our current comprehensive offer.









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Thank you to those families who attended the Headteacher surgery this term when we shared our plans for "The Hills", Thrive approach and Trauma Informed Practice. We will provide more information as each phase launches.

The local authority has also had an Ofsted SEND visit in the past few weeks and it was a delight to be selected as one of only three schools the lead inspector chose to talk to about SEND provision. Thank you to parents and carers who engaged in this process. We will share information from the local authority research visit once it has been published. We work closely with the SEND team of experts at the local authority and value the support they give students, families, and staff at Colton Hills.

Headteacher surgery

The next Headteacher's surgery will be on 18th April at 5pm with Mr Winward and I to discuss our behaviour policy and systems. We really do value your engagement in these sessions and would like to thank the 600 responses we had to the uniform consultation.

We will provide an update on the uniform consultation after ideas have been presented to the Full Governing Board on 9^{th} April and will share the 2024/25 Uniform policy once it has been ratified at that meeting.

Colton Hills Community School recruitment update

Year 6 students have now found out their secondary school placements. We are delighted to be welcoming another bumper year group of 210 students. We have had waiting lists in several year groups this year and we look forward to welcoming them on their transition days in the summer term.

Sixth form update

We will also be running taster sessions in the sixth form for Year 10s and a transition to sixth form experience for Year 11. We are delighted that numbers wishing to stay at Colton Hills continues to rise year on year. You may have noticed our new sixth form logo on the school website and around the school site we have started to improve sixth form signage. Exciting internal improvements are taking place for study spaces and a café space too. We will share the next phase with you via social media channels once they are completed and we will be hosting our sixth form open evening next autumn in the newly refurbished sixth form centre.
