We have a dedicated Sixth Form centre where the Sixth Form team is based to offer support and also a common room for students to unwind, socialise and have their lunches.

There are multiple rooms to cater for group or individual revision including quiet study rooms for independent learning.





Students in the Sixth Form have the opportunity to loan a laptop for the duration of their two-year studies.

At the end of Year 13, they may choose to return the laptop or purchase it for a set fee to support their post-18 education or career plans.







Super Curricular Opportunities

Students benefit from a wide range of super-curricular opportunities. These include enriching trips such as visits to Winter Wonderland in Hyde Park, the UK Parliament and the NEC School and Careers Leavers Festival.

Students also take part in subject-specific trips including visiting universities, zoological trips and play active roles in whole-school events including the school production, open evenings, summer fete and so much more.

EPQ

The Extended Project Qualification (**EPQ**) at Colton Hills Sixth Form is a Level 3, independent research-based qualification worth half an A-Level. Students choose a topic that fascinates them and then design a project that suits, be it a dissertation, an artefact, a performance or a report.

Supervised by staff, students gain invaluable skills such as critical thinking, research and time management. It's a chance to pursue independent learning, demonstrate dedication and stand out in applications, whether heading to university, apprenticeships or the workforce.



Entry Requirements

Courses are structured into pathways, to ensure that students undertake popular subject choices which fit together into clear career routes. This will enable learners to ensure they acquire the skills, knowledge and attributes for a range of specialist fields.

A-Level Courses

These courses are taken over a two-year period and are assessed at the end of Year 13. Each subject has a different advanced course format. Three A-Level courses will be required of students who receive a strong set of GCSE marks.

There are extra GCSE minimum grade requirements for several topics. This route ensures key academic subjects remain separate, so that students can piece together a programme that will offer them access to top university offers.

BTECS

BTECS are also studied over two years; there are a range of subjects on offer. Consisting mostly of coursework, BTEC course would suit those students who prefer a different assessment process to examinations. Like all Level 3 courses, good independent study skills are vital.

They are an alternative to A-Levels if you are a more practical learner or have taken a subject at BTEC Level 2 in Year 11. A BTEC Level 3 Extended Certificate is the equivalent of 1 A-Level subject. A BTEC Level 3 Diploma is the equivalent of 2 A-Level subjects.


