Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to confirm that from **Wednesday 15th June** your child in Year 11 is no longer needed in school except for exams and two scheduled science lessons to support revision.

We are giving students study leave for their final examinations so that they can revise for them in a focused and structured way at home. They are no longer required in school each day, other than for their revision sessions and for any remaining examinations.

In this letter you will also find information regarding the next few weeks as well as some reminders for events that will happen after exams have finished.

Revision Lessons

There are two revision sessions for Science examinations that students should attend (in their normal classrooms). These are:

Friday 17th June – Period 1 – Chemistry Paper 2 revision

Tuesday 21th June – Period 1 – Physics Paper 2 revision

Please arrive on time and go straight to lesson where a register will be taken in the usual way.

Examinations

For all remaining examinations, students should arrive in full school uniform 15 minutes before the scheduled start of the exam and wait outside the PE entrance. Students should leave site as soon as the examination is finished.

Legal duty

When your child is not in school, parents are responsible to safeguard their child and they are also responsible for their supervision at home during normal school hours (8:30am – 3:00pm) where they must complete revision.

Leavers' Assemblies

Students will have the opportunity to celebrate their completion of their GCSE examinations with an official leavers' assembly after their final examination. This will be held on **Thursday 23rd June** at **11.00 am** where they will receive their leaving assembly and have the chance to say goodbye to each other and to staff.

Year 11 Prom

For any students planning to attend Prom, monies are to be paid for in full by Monday 27th June and that arrival is between 7:00-7:30pm at the Grand Station Hotel on **Monday 11th July**. For anyone that wants to order a leavers' hoodie, payment needs to be made by Friday 17th June via ParentPay (£30.00).





Results Day

GCSE results can be collected on **Thursday 25th August 2022** from the school theatre, between 10am and 12pm. If your child is not able to collect their results, please let us know and they can be posted to you if this is needed.

Sixth Form Induction

Our Sixth Form induction is taking place between **Monday 4th July** and **Friday 8th July**. We would like to see all students intending to return to our Sixth Form – or still considering us – at this induction, where they will have a chance to visit a university and to begin to choose options for post-16 study. Places are not guaranteed until we receive results in the summer, but the induction gives students an insight into Sixth Form life and a strong start to their Year 12 studies.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support regarding the above and throughout the GCSE examinations, which have been very successful and have allowed students to show what they can do. Students should continue to work hard for the remaining exams and remember that teachers can still be contacted via Teams if they have questions.
