Please avoid blocking driveways, parking on double yellow lines, or stopping in unsafe areas. These actions not only pose a risk to children and other pedestrians but can also cause unnecessary congestion and frustration. Please arrange to collect your child a little further away from school as this will also reduce congestion for emergency vehicle access to the school site, if needed.

At our school, **respect** is one of our core values. We teach our children to show respect to others in all aspects of their lives, and we ask that this value is reflected in the way we all behave in our school community - including how we park and drive near the school.

Let's work together to keep our children safe and to show consideration for our neighbours and fellow parents and carers.
