| BIOLOGY | Biology involves the study of a wide range of exciting topics, from the molecules that make up life, to how the body works and ecosystems survive. Trips, competitions, and extra opportunities are a regular feature of the course. The course is designed to encourage students to develop an enthusiasm for biology, learn practical and thinking skills alongside an understanding of concepts and principles and build a solid foundation of knowledge and skills for studying medicine, pharmacy, dentistry, veterinary science, or any biology related degree or apprenticeship. |
