COLTON HILLS COMMUNITY SCHOOL

Rationale

This policy sets out the schools arrangements for managing the access of providers to students at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the providers education and training offer. This complies with the schools legal obligations under section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Student Entitlement

All students in year 7 -13 are entitled:

- To find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeship opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point.
- To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical
 education and apprenticeships through options events, assemblies, group discussions and taster
 events.
- To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

The Governing Body may, from time to time, amend the categories of activities for which a charge may be made. Nothing in this policy precludes the Governing Body from inviting parents to make a voluntary contribution towards the cost of providing additional activities for the students.

Any insurance costs will be included in charges for trips or activities.
