Dear Parents/Carers,

Whilst the vast majority of students embrace and adhere to our uniform and appearance policy, there have been some instances of incorrect unform. I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of our school uniform expectations. The full policy including pictures of acceptable items can be found on the school website Uniform Policy - Expectations but I wanted to highlight a few points.

- CHCS Blazers compulsory must be worn at all times.
- CHCS School Jumper (optional but should not be worn instead of a blazer)
- Black shoes (no trainers, pumps or boots, please refer to the pictures). Some students have been wearing trainers since September, this will not be acceptable in the New Year.
- Jewellery (Only a small pair of plain studs in the lower lobe and a watch no nose studs, necklaces, bracelets)
- Coat no hoodies or tracksuit jackets.
- Hair (no unnatural colours e.g. blue, purple).
- When students have PE or dance, students are required to wear their Colton Hills Branded PE kit. This should only be worn on those day.

For the best possible start to the new term please ensure your child arrives to school wearing the correct uniform and they are equipped ready to learn. The equipment list can be found on the uniform and appearance policy link above or on our school website. We are following the 2022/23 uniform policy and will be consulting with parents regarding uniform for the next academic year soon. If your child does attend school in incorrect uniform, you will be contacted to bring in the items of missing or incorrect uniform, or they will be loaned items to wear. If your child refuses to wear the offered loaned items, the behaviour policy will be followed, and they will be sanctioned.
