I recently sent a letter to you about opportunities to find out more about becoming an airline pilot. Subsequently, I have been in touch with Aerobility; a charity who focus on providing anyone with any disability to access the magic and wonder of flight. Their aim is to show students with a disability that "if they can fly an aeroplane, what else could they do?"

Aerobility have begun offering a Virtual Aviation Experience. Please read through the details below and if your child is interested, ask them to use the link to complete the application form.

Details:

**Focus:** A free 3-part course designed for individuals 12 years or older with disabilities to learn the basics of flight and develop transferable skills. Each of the three sessions that make up the course consist of a 30-minute briefing followed by a 30-minute simulator flight using a Piper Cherokee Warrior aircraft accessed remotely through an internet browser.

**Host:** Aerobility

**Date:** Ongoing

**Location:** Online

**Cost:** Free

**Technology requirements:** Any laptop or desktop PC with internet connectivity and Microsoft Teams video and audio capabilities.
