Dear Parents/Carers,

Recently we have been discussing Post 16 options with your child and supporting them to consider where they would like to study for further education. Legally all children must be in some form of Education or Training until they are 18 years old, so it is crucial we support students to consider the correct courses they would like to consider for their chosen career.

To support student's, we have collated a list of open days at local colleges (please see attached document) and we will be hosting a mini careers fayre for year 11 students on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> May during their enrichment session until 3pm. Students will have the opportunity to speak to colleges and providers after school and be supported in applying if required.

Students have also received assemblies to highlight what we offer in our Sixth Form, and the benefits of staying with us to complete their A level or BTECs if this is the right choice for them. Students are required to achieve grade 4's in 5 subjects including English and Maths. However, some courses have specific requirements and will require Grade 6 in certain subjects. Those who have applied have been offered an interview with the Sixth Form team, however it is not too late to apply if you haven't done so already just click on the link:
