Dear Parents/Carers of Year 11

Rising Y12 Sixth Form Induction Day Tuesday 7th July 8:30am – 3pm

We are delighted to invite your child to attend our Sixth Form Induction Day on **Tuesday 7th July 2025**, as part of their transition from Year 11 to Sixth Form – becoming one of our rising Year 12s!

This day is an important opportunity for students to experience life in the Sixth Form at Colton Hills Community School. They will take part in subject-specific taster sessions, meet their Post 16 teachers and peers and receive key information about expectations, support and opportunities available to them over the next two years. There will also be sessions designed to help them prepare for the academic and personal challenges of Sixth Form life.

We believe that a successful transition into Sixth Form is built on confidence, connection and clarity and this day aims to provide all three. It is the first step in their Post 16 exciting journey and we strongly encourage all invited students to attend.

The day

Students should arrive for an 8:30am start in the Theatre, where we will go through introductions to Sixth Form life, how Sixth Form differs from KS4 and information about summer transition work that will need to be completed before September.

Students will then have the exceptional opportunity to go to four different 1-hour lessons from Period 1 to Period 4. These will be taught by our Sixth Form teachers so you can experience what a KS5 lesson is like. Students will have the opportunity to ask questions throughout the day and will leave to go home at 3:00pm.

What can I wear on Induction Day?

- ✓ Smart trousers/ chinos
- ✓ Smart shoes (leather if studying Science)
- ✓ Skirt/ smart tailored shorts/ dress (all at professional length)
- ✓ Natural hair colour/ style
- ✓ Discrete piercings and makeup in line with whole school policy

The following are **not** allowed as part of our Sixth Form dress code:

- Sportswear - including hoodies, sports T shirts, trainers
- Hats, caps, durags, non-religious headwear
- Leggings
- Jeans
- Cropped, strappy or low cut tops
- Overt branding/ inappropriate slogans
- Piercings which would be deemed unsuitable for a professional setting (belly, spacers)
- Open toed sandals/ flip flops/ crocs
- Tattoos (illegal under 18; over 18 tattoos must not be visible)

Please ensure you wear smart modern business wear on Induction Day!
