Prom Date and Venue

- All guests must have arrived by **7.30pm**
- There is an area directly in front of the venue for vehicle drop-off
- Parents/carers who wish to see pupils arrive must remain behind the front gates
- Parents/carers will not be permitted inside the venue — this is a venue rule and must be adhered to

Event Supervision and Safety

The evening will be closely supervised by school staff and supported by venue security, ensuring a safe, enjoyable, and well-organised celebration for all attendees.

Food and Refreshments

- A buffet-style meal will be provided
- There will be a bar selling soft drinks only
- Pupils may wish to bring a small amount of money or an alternative payment method to purchase drinks
