White shirt		Compulsory	Can be purchased at any supplier as long as they button up fully to the neck and can be tucked into skirt/trousers
Grey, white or black socks	N/A	Compulsory unless wearing tights.	
Black/Grey or skin coloured tights.	N/A	Optional (if wearing skirt, compulsory)	
Black shoes	See below	Compulsory	

The following examples show what types of shoe styles are acceptable and suitable to be worn with school uniform. They should be entirely black and leather or a leather style in appearance. They should not have any logos or writing on them. Trainers, canvas plimsolls/pumps, boots (long or ankle), high heels or sandals are not acceptable. Shoes should not be adorned with metallic trims or decorations.
